Pine Needle Park Redevelopment

Council approved the Pine Needle Park Redevelopment Plan for inclusion into the Parks and Trails Master Plan. The District will focus on creating a natural play area, and will work with the Community Enhancement Society and neighbouring residents. A picnic table, bear bin, and sign are recommended.

Columbia Basin Broadband Corporation (CBBC)

The District of Elkford granted a license of occupation to CBBC for the data room at the Elkford Community Conference Centre. The room will be utilized for their Information Technology equipment that will be used in establishing a broadband connection in Elkford.

Bylaws

Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 787, 2016 was adopted. The bylaw will have the effect of rezoning the property at 218 Alpine Way from Town Center Commercial to Single-Unit Residential.
