Canfor Delegation

Ian Johnson provided an update on logging activities in Elkford area. Recent logging areas included Aldridge, Bingay, Britt Creek Flats and upper Elk East side. The following areas will be logged in the near future: Weary Creek, Gardiner Creek, Aldridge, and Porter Creek. The company will be focusing their efforts on spruce beetle management.
