Sparwood Coal Miner Days Parade

The District of Elkford will participate in the Coal Miner Days Parade in Sparwood on June 9th. Elkford to Receive \$25,000 Grant for the New Energy Efficient District Office

Considering the District's commitment to energy efficiency, the District of Elkford entered into an agreement with the North Growth Foundation for \$25,000 in matching funding to install a solar photovoltaic energy generation system at the new District Office.

Council approved the Permit for the new District of Elkford Municipal Office at 744 Fording Drive. The official Groundbreaking Ceremony for the new facility took place on May 24, 2018. Minor site preparation has already begun, and construction will amp up over the next few weeks.
