### Teck Coal Ltd. Outlined Details to Council re: Temporary Use Permit for Workplace Accommodations

Representatives from Teck presented Council the company's plan for a temporary workplace accommodation facility on Highway 43 which will house workers that will be in the Elk Valley for the construction of Teck's three water treatment facilities.

### Westridge Rock Ltd. Outlined Details to Council re: Temporary Use Permit at 17 and 19 Bear Paw Crescent

Representatives from Westridge Rock presented Council its plan for a temporary office and three temporary office/dwelling units, and their future development plans for their property.

### Council Approved Development Variance Permit (DVP) No. 18-03

Council approved the DVP for a front yard accessory building at 1116 Ash Crescent.

Councillor Ken Wildeman served as Councillor for the past 10 years and Councillor Joe Zarowny for the past 9 years.

### Bylaws

- **District of Elkford Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 808, 2018** was adopted. This Bylaw allows the District to regulate cannabis retail through zoning.
- **District of Elkford Business Licence Amendment Bylaw No. 811, 2018** was adopted. This Bylaw amends the Business Licence Bylaw to include cannabis retail, cannabis production facilities and medical marijuana production facilities. The amendments include definitions and provide the ability for Council to be the business licence granting authority for these uses.
- **District of Elkford Smoking Regulation Bylaw No. 814, 2018** was adopted. This Bylaw regulates the places where people are permitted to smoke and includes regulations for smoking cannabis.
- **District of Elkford Ticket Information Utilization Amendment Bylaw No. 815, 2018** was adopted. This Bylaw provides a schedule of fines associated with the District of Elkford Smoking Regulation Bylaw No. 814, 2018.
