Family Skating	Adults and parents/guardians (18+) and their children	 Helmets are strongly recommended <u>Adults are required to supervise children</u> (either on the ice or from the bleachers) No rink attendant is present No hockey/shinny or pucks are permitted 	 Skating during school hours is offered to accommodate people and families who are not working or in school at that time (e.g., homeschoolers, pre-kindergarten children, shift workers, etc.) For everyone's safety, and to promote equitable ice usage for all participants, hockey/shinny and pucks are NOT permitted on the ice.
