We can't wait to see you again in the fall, for the start of the 2023 to 2024 skating season!





Can we get a show of hands for who hates the spring melt? The worst part isn't even the mud and slushy mess that winter leaves behind, it's the mountains of dog waste and litter left behind by inconsiderate folks that appear as the snow melts.

Please pick up after yourself and your pets! Dog waste doesn't belong on our trails and trash does not belong in the backcountry, in our parks, along forest service roads, in greenspaces or at McGulley's (where the yellow bins used to be situated).

What can you do with your household garbage and recyclables? The Elkford Transfer Station, operated by the RDEK, handles all recycling in Elkford at 6 Inkaneep Road in the Industrial Park.

Currently, the Elkford Transfer station is open six days per week, from Monday to Saturday, excluding statutory holidays.
