#### **Watering Restrictions Start April 1**

It may seem early, but April will be here before you know it!

To ensure capacity of Elkford's reservoirs in the event of a fire emergency (and adequate water for all throughout the summer) watering between **April 1 and September 30** is to take place on odd-or-even-numbered days CORRESPONDING WITH YOUR RESIDENTIAL STREET ADDRESS. On the calendar days that correspond with your street address (odd or even), remember that you may only water within the hours of **7 p.m. to 10 a.m.** (amended in the Good Neighbour Bylaw, No. 781, 2022).

#### **Bleeder Valves: ON**

A friendly reminder to all residents to turn **ON** the bleeder valves in your residences from **October 31 to May 1**. This important bylaw is in place to prevent your pipes from freezing and cracking in colder temperatures.

#### **Winter Parking Bylaw**

Winter comes early in Elkford, and thanks to our high elevation, it also often ends last (which is either great or terrible, depending on how much you enjoy winter sports).

A friendly reminder that on-street parking is NOT permitted in Elkford between the hours of **6 a.m. and 4 p.m.** from **November 1 to March 31** (inclusive). This bylaw is in place so that Public Works can perform efficient and effective snow removal.

#### **Keep Kids off of Roadside Snowbanks**

Every time it snows, Public Works operators work to cut back snow banks and snow piles to widen our roadways. Please ensure that children do not play in snow berms or on snow piles along roads.

Operators don't have x-ray vision: they are unable to see tunnels carved in the snow and cannot always see children who are playing on snow banks. Additionally, tunneling in snow piles is very dangerous in itself, often resulting in fatalities when snow forts collapse.

Please play it safe—don't use snowbanks as a playground!



## SPRING REMINDERS



Can we get a show of hands for who hates the spring melt? The worst part isn't even the mud and slushy mess that winter leaves behind, it's the mountains of dog waste and litter left behind by inconsiderate folks that appear as the snow melts.

Please pick up after yourself and your pets! Dog waste doesn't belong on our trails and trash does not belong in the backcountry, in our parks, along forest service roads, in greenspaces or at McGulley's (where the yellow bins used to be situated).

What can you do with your household garbage and recyclables? The **Elkford Transfer Station**, operated by the RDEK, handles all recycling in Elkford at **6 Inkaneep Road** in the Industrial Park.

Currently, the Elkford Transfer station is open *six days per week*, from Monday to Saturday, excluding statutory holidays.
